Original diaries are held at the ARHS Rail Resource Centre, Redfern NSW. These notes only cover items perceived to be of interest to light railway readers and researchers. As the diaries also cover his Government railway travels and observations (which are not indexed here), it is possible that there are small observations on light rail that have been missed, larger items may have also been missed if I did not recognize the significance of the location. If you are looking for an area of interest that I do not list, I suggest searching diaries where he has been in the same area as your area of interest, or may have travelled through that area (e.g. a visit to Port Kembla would typically be via train from Sydney, thus small observations might be made of colliery tramways along to route).
